Assignment 2 Color Correction on various images

Take the folder *Assignment 2 files* from my Take-Out box and work from your machine's folder or your zip, making sure to save often as you work.

There are three files that need correction: *Ducky*, *Fern* and *Temple*. Rename the files with your initials before the name, (i.e. like this: nlg-Ducky, nlg-Fern, nlg-Temple). Place the finished files in a folder with your last name,first initial_A2 (i.e., GrajalesN_A2) and upload it to my drop box.

Follow the instructions given for each of the three images. Save each file as a native Photoshop (.psd) layered file. Do not flatten any of the files as I want to see your work.

- 1. Ducky:** Remove the halo so the edge of the duck looks as good as possible.
- 2. Fern:** Isolate the fern from the background and place on a separate layer. Make the isolated fern look as good as possible.
- 3. Temple:** Correct the temple image to have full tonal range and lightened midtones. Adjust the ink percentages Curve so no dark in over 95% or there is a 5% dot in the *no ink* areas.
